## Rhino Readers Decodable Books Matching the Red Rose Letters and Sounds Programme Progression



## **Using this Matching Document**

This book matching document will help you match Twinkl's Rhino Readers decodable phonics books to the Red Rose Letters and Sounds programme. The Rhino Readers books can be used to support and complement teaching from Phases 1 to 5 of the programme. The following chart will show you when each book title becomes decodable and can be used with your learners. Following the progression in this document will ensure that children are reading books consistent with their developing phonic knowledge and are not presented with words they are not yet able to decode successfully.

Books matching Phase 1 have been arranged according to the aspect of learning they support.

Books matching Phases 2-5 have been arranged according to the progression of grapheme-phoneme correspondences (GPCs) and tricky / common exception words covered in the programme. For each week of teaching, the content covered and the books that match are shown, together with any relevant notes or words that need to be pre-taught. Please note that as the books may contain any of the GPCs and tricky / common exception words taught up to the end of the given week, they should be shared with learners at the end of each week of teaching.

We would always advise checking through a book before sharing, to ensure there are no GPCs or tricky / common exception words not yet covered in phonics teaching.
